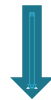


❑ DURATION OF HOUSE OF THE PEOPLE–

The normal life of the house of the people is 5 years, but it may be dissolved earlier by the president.

❑ QUALIFICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP OF LOKSABHA–

- a) Must be a citizen of India.
- b) Must be not less than 25 years of age.
- c) Additional Qualification may be prescribed by parliament by Law. (art–84)

❑ DISQUALIFICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP–

- a) If he holds any office of profit under the government of India or the government of any state
 - b) If he is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court.
 - c) If he is an undischarged insolvent.
 - d) If he is not a citizen of India
 - e) If he is so disqualified by or under any law made by parliament.

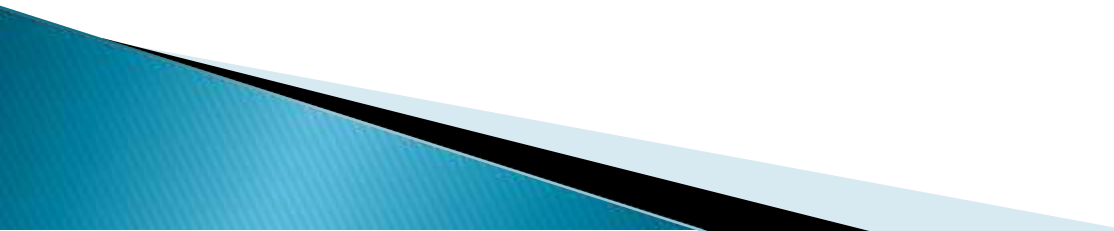
