Introduction

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 focuses on higher education changes that will prepare the next generation to prosper and complete in the digital age. The National Education Policy (NEP)2020, which was released on July 29, 2020, defines India's future educational system's aim. To guarantee continuous development NEP 2020 focuses on five pillars: affordability, accessibility, quality, equity and accountability.

The Academic Bank of Credits (ABC)

As per the parameters of National Education Policy 2020 in Sariya college, Suriya ABC account is opened at time of enrollment of students from session 2023-2027. In which the credits received by the students are transferred to that account.

The Academic Bank of credits (ABC), a National -level facility will promote the flexibility of the curriculum framework and interdisciplinary, multi disciplinary Academic mobility of students across the HEIS in the country with appropriate “Credit transfer” Mechanism.

Our parental university Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribag, is registered under National Academic Depository (NAD). Students of our college get certificates from the parental university. Our university has made it compulsory for all students of U.G. level to get registered under Academic Bank of Credit (ABC). From session 2023-27, it is the provision that ABC registration is compulsory for getting class Roll Number from the college. The student's credit is based upon their performance in the examination. ABC is very convenient for the students to store the credit which they have earned, helpful for the inter-college, inter-university and inter-state transfer of the academic's credits of the students and for further use. Simply they can download it. It is also safe for students. Common Service Centre (CSC) in our college campus is always ready for helping the students to create ABC number. The College always follows the regulations of Vinoba Bhave University (VBU) for the implementation of ABC

in view of NEP-2020. Joint degrees and credit transfer are the domain of the parental university and the college follows the system as and when implemented by the University.

Internship

Sariya college, Suriya organizes internship from time to time for the all- round development of the students. Under this program students are provided with practical work to learn new skills.

As per NEP 2020 guidelines students pursuing undergraduate programs have to undertake internship during the course. Following the guidelines Sariya college has set up research and development cell to guide the students undertaking internship. The institute will encourage the students to go for summer winter internship during the semester break to get the on-site experiential learning.

Academic and research

Academic and research cell has been established with the aim of promoting academic and research in our college. Through this cell, teachers and students are motivated for new research.

Multidisciplinary

Keeping in mind the criteria of NEP in Sariya college, Suriya Science (along with Arts & Commerce) faculty was started in the college from the year 2023. So that students can get more options in choosing the subject.

Multi-disciplinary approach is a unique method in teaching-learning programme. It is a unique way of curriculum integration to illustrate a theme, subject or issue with the help of divergent subject. In a multi-disciplinary curriculum, multiple- discipline are used to study the same topic or content. It is a powerful method of teaching that crosses the boundaries of a discipline or a curriculum in order to enrich and enhance the subject area.

Sariya College, Suriya is permanently affiliated to Vinoba Bhave University (VBU), Hazaribag and follows the curriculum of VBU. During 2015-18, (Choice Based Credit System) CBCS system was introduced by the university and followed by our college in UG programmes. Our state govt. and parental University have implemented NEP-2020 since the session 2022-26 that will offer multiple entry and multiple exits in undergraduate education while maintaining the flow of learning. It is now Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP). Under this programme, a student has to study different papers out of Humanities and Social Science, Natural and Physical Science, Commerce and Management, Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Application stream. Our college envisions to transform itself into a holistic multidisciplinary/interdisciplinary institution. A Student of Sem.-I, has to study/select a major paper (Honours), an Introductory Regular Course/Minor paper leading to Minor which was previously called subsidiary or generic paper, a paper named Understanding India, Entrepreneurship, Health & wellness, Yoga Education and Sports and fitness and finally a paper named M.I.L (Hindi/English).

Dual programme

In Sariya college, Suriya students are provided the facility of GST and Tally, Yoga course, along with graduation studies under dual programme. Students can take admission in that courses even during graduation and can obtain two degrees simultaneously.

Indian knowledge system

Indian knowledge system (IKS) is a division of the Government of India's ministry of education which purports to promote indigenous India systems of knowledge.

We have affiliation for offering Khortha (a regional language), Sanskrit, Hindi, Urdu. Khortha is a regional language of Jharkhand. We have some old, rare, reference books. We are in the process to preserve books on Ancient Indian knowledge system. We follow bi-lingual method for classroom teaching because a large number of students come from very rural background. Generally, even slow learners are taught through Khortha language. Students are oriented with Indian knowledge system.

Joint programme

As per NEP, a branch of Jharkhand State Open University, Ranchi has been established in Sariya college, Suriya under the joint programme. Under which diploma and degree, studies have been started in Sariya college, Suriya.

A joint degree programme is a formally approved and authorized programme between two co-operating graduate or graduate and professional programmes that permits the use of a limited number of credits to fulfill requirements in both programmes.

Indian knowledge system

The Indian knowledge system aim to support and facilitate further research to solve contemporary social issues. Academic research cell has been established in Sariya college, Suriya for this work under which the ancient traditions and knowledge of India are to be revived. Through this cell, ancient knowledge, literature and innovation are discovered through various programmes and the students are encouraging to work further in this direction.

Multiple Entry/Exit

As per the provisions of NEP, arrangements for multiple entry and exit have been made in Sariya college, Suriya for the convenience of the students. Under this, some seats are reserved in each subject.

The multiple entry and exit options for students is facilitate at the undergraduate levels. It would facilitate credit accumulation through the facility created by the ABC scheme in the “Academic Bank Account” opened for students across the country to transfer and consolidate the credits earned by them by undergoing courses in any of the eligible HEI’s. The multiple entry and exit system need to register in the ABC to enable acceptance of multidisciplinary courses, credit transfer and credit acceptance.
