Sariya College, Suriya: An Overview

The establishment of Sariya College in 1984 stands as a testament to the visionary initiatives of the Sariya block's eminent civil society members, who sought to provide accessible higher education for the local youth. This foundational goal was rooted in a commitment to inclusivity, aiming to serve students from all backgrounds, particularly those from historically disadvantaged sections of society, including OBC, SC, and ST communities.

Initially granted temporary affiliation by Ranchi University for Arts faculty degree courses in the 1984-85 session, the college quickly cemented its vital role in the region. It proudly became the sole co-educational degree college within the Bagodar legislative assembly of Giridih district, dedicated to democratizing education and fostering social mobility.

The institution's journey of growth and formal recognition has been marked by significant milestones. It achieved a major accomplishment by securing permanent affiliation from the Jharkhand government and Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribag, for both Arts and Commerce faculties at the General Level, starting from the 2011-12 academic session. This validation of its academic standards was further strengthened with the grant of permanent affiliation for Arts at the Honours Level from the 2014-15 session, enabling a more specialized and in-depth curriculum for its students.

The college's physical foundation was made possible through the generous philanthropy of esteemed individuals like Sri Mahabir Pd. Jain and Sri Janki Lal Daga, who donated the essential land for the campus to the Hon'ble Governor of Jharkhand. Their enduring contribution, among many others, has been instrumental in the college's successful completion of over three decades of service.

Bolstered by this legacy of community support and driven by its founding mission, Sariya College continues to strive towards its core objective: empowering the youth through quality education and molding them into informed, proactive, and responsible citizens for the nation.





Sariya College: Nurturing Minds, Empowering a Rural Community

A product of grassroots initiative, Sariya College has been a cornerstone of the Sariya block since its inception, embodying the power of a community's vision to harness education for transformation. Established in 1984 through the concerted efforts of eminent civil society members, the college was founded upon a profound and urgent mission: to bring accessible higher education to the doorsteps of local youth, particularly those from historically weaker and marginalized sections of society. In a region where educational opportunities were scarce, the institution emerged as a beacon of hope and a catalyst for social mobility, dedicated to the principle that enlightenment and empowerment are the birthright of every individual, irrespective of their background.

The college's journey began with a modest yet determined inception. In its inaugural 1984-85 session, it welcomed a pioneering batch of just 14 students into the faculties of Arts and Commerce, operating with a handful of dedicated teaching staff under the temporary affiliation of Ranchi University. From these humble beginnings, Sariya College quickly cemented its vital role as the sole co-educational degree college within the Bagodar legislative assembly. Its doors were open to all, with a special focus on uplifting students from OBC, SC, and ST communities, thereby actively democratizing the landscape of higher education in a rural context.

Through decades of unwavering commitment, the college has achieved significant milestones that underscore its growth and academic credibility. A pivotal moment in its history was the grant of permanent affiliation from the Jharkhand government and Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribagh, for both Arts and Commerce faculties at the General Level, effective from the 2011-12 academic session. This validation was further strengthened with permanent affiliation for Arts at the Honours Level from the 2014-15 session. Today, the college offers a robust and diverse range of Undergraduate programmes under the Four Year Under Graduate Program (FYUGP), including a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in disciplines such as English, Economics, Geography, Hindi, History, Khortha, Political Science, Geography, Philosophy, Sanskrit, Sociology, and Urdu; a Bachelor of Science in Botany, Zoology, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics alongside a comprehensive Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) degree.

The institutional integrity and quality of Sariya College are firmly anchored by its formal recognitions and governance structure. The college is registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, and holds the critical distinction of being recognized under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of





the University Grants Commission (UGC), making it eligible for central government grants. Its commitment to quality assurance is demonstrated by its accreditation from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) under the Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF) and a certification from the International Organization for Standardization (ISO). Strategic oversight is provided by a dedicated Governing Body, constituted of seven members, which includes the Principal as an ex-officio member and a democratically elected Teacher's Representative, ensuring collaborative and transparent administration.

Beyond academics, Sariya College has cultivated a vibrant ecosystem for holistic development. The institution has earned a reputation as one of the leading multidisciplinary colleges in the region, a status built upon consistent performance in both academic and extra-curricular spheres. Faithful to its founding vision, the college relentlessly pursues excellence with a clear focus on serving its rural constituency. It meticulously sensitizes its student body to pressing contemporary issues such as gender equality and environmental sustainability. This is achieved through an integrated approach that blends curriculum design with a dynamic array of co-curricular activities—including awareness programs, seminars, symposiums, theatrical productions, quiz competitions, cultural festivals, and the celebration of national and international days.

Ultimately, Sariya College is more than an institution of learning; it is a vital community resource committed to providing the means for its students to grow, develop, and flourish. 
