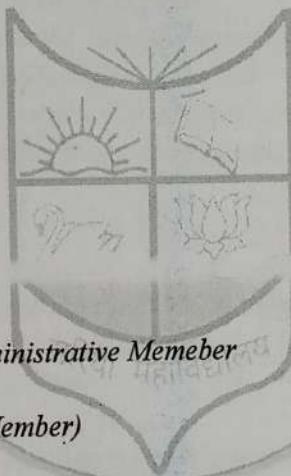

Discussion: -

The I.Q.A.C. coordinator welcomed all the members for the discussion of the agenda. The following points were discussed in the meeting: -

Agenda no. 1:

The proceeding of the last meeting (meeting no. 34) was read by the I.Q.A.C. coordinator and confirmed by all the members with the following suggestions: -

- All IQAC nodal officers were instructed to submit the data of their respective cells for AQAR 2024-25 to the IQAC Coordinator by 24.12.2025.
- The nodal officers concerned with the Annual Future Plan were recommended to prepare the Annual Future Plan by keeping it aligned with the IDP.
- The Research Committee was instructed to conduct a meeting by the first week of January 2026, in which the working methodology for research development in the institute will be discussed and shared.

Agenda no. 2:

After confirmation of the last meeting (meeting no. 34), A rough ATR has been presented in today's I.Q.A.C. meeting and finalised with the above suggestions.

Agenda no. 3:

In this meeting, a discussion was held regarding the post sanctioning of teachers, during which it was informed that at present the state government is not taking any action regarding post sanctioning. As a result, students of Semester 7 are facing problems related to admission in Bachelor's Degree (Honours with Research course). Despite the matter being raised in the Legislative Assembly by the Hon'ble M.L.A. (Bagodar) -cum- Chairman of our present Governing Body, Shri Nagendra Mahto on 11/12/2025. No attention has been paid to this issue by the state government. The management of our institute was requested to give due and serious attention to the problems related to this matter.

Agenda no. 4:

The IQAC has instructed the Nodal Officer of the Autonomous Committee, Sri R.K. Mishra, along with the committee members Dr. Pramod Kumar and Dr. Sweta, to convene a meeting at the earliest and to review the progress.

Agenda no. 5:

For better academic achievement, it was decided that the names and photographs of rank holders and alumni of this college who are serving in Civil Services or in Gazetted Officer positions should be displayed on boards at various places in the campus buildings, so that students may feel motivated by seeing them.

It was also decided that in the next meeting, all teachers will be asked to present their respective opinions and suggestions for better academic achievement.

Agenda no. 6:

In this meeting, it was decided that quarterly performance appraisals of all college staff will be prepared from now onwards. For this purpose, the concerned nodal officer, Shri R. K. Mishra, was recommended to prepare a fresh performance appraisal format, in which both quantitative as well as qualitative evaluations can be carried out.

On the suggestion of Shri Rajesh Kumar Jain, Management Member of the IQAC, it was decided that just as staff members are penalized when their performance in the performance appraisal is not satisfactory, those with the best performance will also be rewarded.

Agenda no. 7:

As per the instructions of Dr. Santosh Kumar Lal, Chairman of the IQAC, it was decided that separate introductory sessions will be organised for the nodal officers of each allotted cell on a month-wise basis, in order to provide information about the assigned tasks under the ten NAAC criteria.
